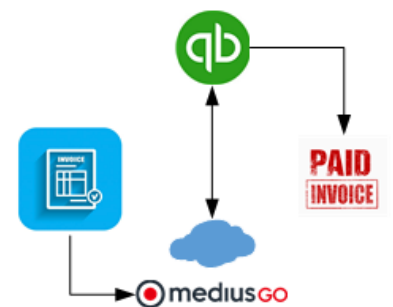
Integrating MediusGo with Intuit's QuickBooks (On-Premise or Online)

QuickBooks Integration Details

MediusGo provides direct API integration to both versions of Intuit QuickBooks. Below are high-level requirements:

- Integrated via QuickBooks API that is backward and forward compatible.
- Active category and/or item details must be provided for mapping into MediusGo coding dimensions.
- The MediusGo connector must be registered as an authorized app for each company in QuickBooks Online.



- On-premise integration requires the SDK to be installed. To download, click this link: [Desktop SDK 14.0 Installer](#).
- On-premise requires the MediusGo connector to be copied to a workstation or QuickBooks application server.
- On-premise editions require the application to be authorized with access when QuickBooks is not running.
- Use Windows Task Scheduler at a regular interval to perform synchronization of master data and transactions.
